The course on “**Blue Bio-refinery technologies: from research to the industry with applications on products and biomaterial from algal biomass and sidestreams of fisheries and aquaculture**” is supported by ERA-NET Cofund on Blue Bioeconomy *Unlocking the Potential of Aquatic Bioresources* (BlueBio), co-organised with the National Research Council (CNR Italy) and the University of Foggia (Italy), with the patronage of the European Society of Marine Biotechnology (ESMB), is now open for applications.
